- Length
 - Articles= 6,000 words or less
 - Notes= 3,000 words or less
- Chicago Manual of Style
 - Endnote citations only
- .DOC, .DOCX, or WPD files only
- Submission Format= Last Name, First Name-Winter 2016
MJPA (Article/Note/Special Issue)
- Read the “Statement of Disclosure” and “Copyright Notice”
prior to submitting work

Application Timeline

- Call for Submissions Released: **October 10, 2016***
- Final Application Deadline: **December 31, 2016 at 11:59 pm***
- Conditional Acceptance: **Mid-January 2016 (Date TBA)**
- Authors whose papers are conditionally accepted for publication in MJPA will be notified of further details

Special Issue

- Underrepresented policy issues determined by MJPA Leadership
- Vol. 14 Solicitations: Health Equity, Housing Policy and Criminal Justice
- Manuscripts, Notes, Op Eds, Alternative Policy Writing, and Photo Essays will be accepted for this category only
- Same general guidelines as traditional submissions category
 - Chicago Style
 - Endnote citations
 - Submission Format
- < 2,000 words or < 2 pages if submitting original visual aids
